Upon a motion by Braun and seconded by Hermanson, it was moved to approve the minutes of the July 13th, 2022 meeting. Ayes Annexstad, Hermanson, Braun, Kral, Hulke. Carried.

Upon a motion by Hulke and seconded by Kral, it was moved to approve 35 paid bills for July 2022 totaling \$46,393.47 (Checking Account), and 0 paid bills for July 2022 (Grants Account) and 31 paid bills for August 2022 totaling \$38,331.93 (Checking Account), and 0 paid bills for August 2022 (Grants Account). 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New Business:

2021 Financial Audit: The 2021 final audit report was given to each Board member. No motion needed.

Nicollet County 4-H Demonstration Awards: Kaden Kruse and Amelia Kruse were the recipients of the Nicollet County 4-H Awards this year. Kaden's demonstration was on red-tailed hawks. Amelia's was on bats. They each received \$25.00 from the SWCD. No motion needed.

2023 LWG Resource Concerns Results: Ostermann reported that the 2023 resource concerns are the same as last year; the top 6 resource concerns from 2022 were: wind and water erosion; concentrated erosion; soil quality limitations; filed sediment, nutrient and pathogen loss; field pesticide loss; degraded plant condition. The concerns have been submitted to the NRCS area office. Informational only. No motion needed.

Area VI Meeting Nov. 15th hosted by Waseca SWCD: Upon a motion by Hulke and seconded by Kral, it was moved to approve that staff and Supervisors attend the Area VI Meeting on Nov. 15th. Ayes Annexstad, Hermanson, Braun, Kral, Hulke. Carried.

MASWCD Conference Dec. 13-14 @ Doubletree in Bloomington: Upon a motion by Hermanson and seconded by Hulke, the Board approved the staff and Supervisors to attend the MASWCD Conference in Bloomington. Ayes Annexstad, Hermanson, Braun, Kral, Hulke. Carried.

State Grant Contract: A motion was made by Hermanson and seconded by Braun, to approve that Ostermann and Annexstad sign an agreement with the DNR which states that the Nicollet SWCD will administer the \$400,000 grant and act as project managers to take out the dam near Hwy 99 and 13. Ayes Annexstad, Hermanson, Braun, Kral, Hulke. Carried.

Cost-Share: The District received a request regarding Cost-Share Contract 2(22) & 1(23), to enter a contract to assist in constructing a WASCOB Structure. Total estimated cost of the project is \$20,790.00 with cost-share of \$11,779.00. Upon a motion by Kral and seconded by Hermanson, it was moved to approve Cost-Share Contract 2(22) & 1(23) for \$11,779.00. Ayes Annexstad, Hermanson, Braun, Kral, Hulke. Carried.
